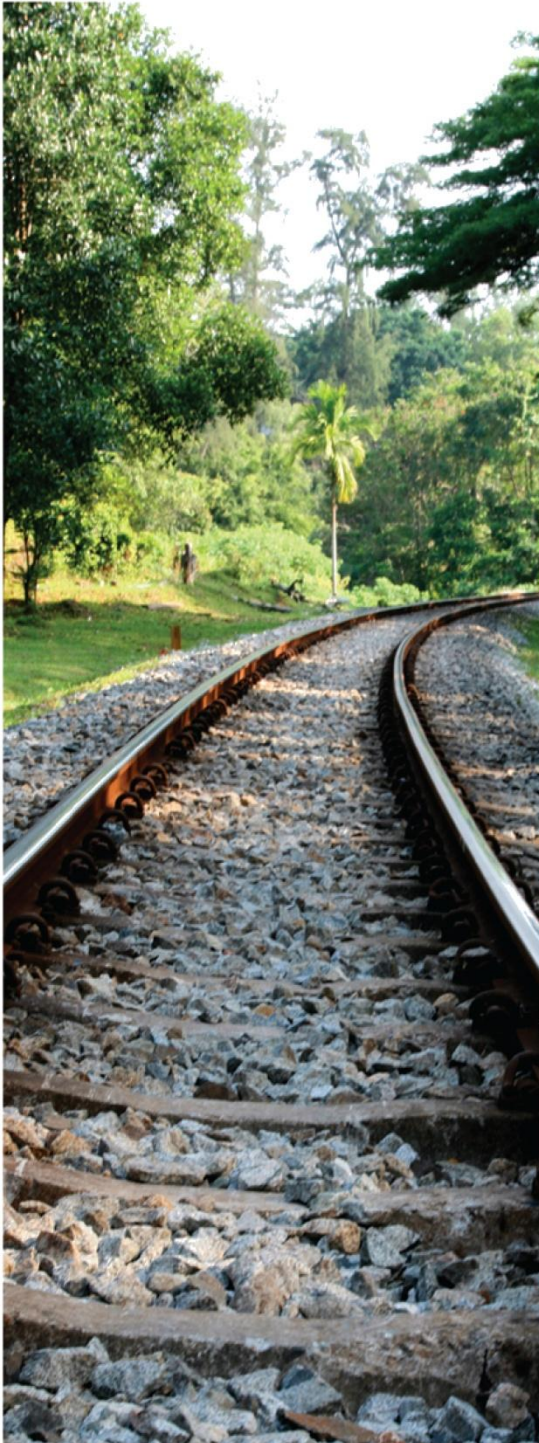

PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Rail and Intermodal Transportation Exploration is a week-long program designed to create awareness and stimulate interest in the area of rail & intermodal transportation. The program is a collaborative effort by Michigan Tech's Rail Transportation Program and the Transportation and Logistics Management Program at the University of Wisconsin – Superior.

HOW TO APPLY

Enrollment is first-come, first-served. Students must complete the scholarship application (provided on the back of this handout) which includes a teacher recommendation, school transcript, and short answer questions. *Students must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA to receive this scholarship.*
